
SLRC BOOSTER TRAVEL POLICY

To help avoid issues concerning liabilities involving team self-transportation and lodging and the incurrence of cancellation fees, the following policy shall cover the Junior rowing program of SLRC as regards travel.

All team members are to travel with the team. Separate lodging and transportation must be approved by the Head Coach at least four days prior to the event; this will allow the Booster Board time necessary to adjust for total team transportation and lodging.

Travel fees shall include, but not be limited to the following items:

- Team transportation to/from the regatta or event;
- Team lodging;
- Team food/snacks during the regatta, but not travel meals or meals prior to the beginning of the competition such as the night before supper;
- Regatta fees;
- Other fees associated with the regatta as deemed necessary or of value to the team, such as the box meal program and shell transportation.

The total fee of participating in a regatta will be coordinated with the Booster Treasurer. Based upon the total number of participants, the Treasurer shall determine the total cost per rower.

Parents/Guardians of rowers who do not wish the rower to participate in team-provided benefits (e.g., transportation):

- Will still participate in the sharing of the total costs, including that benefit which they do not wish to participate in;
- In the case of alternative transportation, the parent/guardian must:
 - Provide the Head Coach a waiver of said desire and a release of liability to the team;
 - Provide the Head Coach with a statement of who is providing the transportation to/from the event; the statement will provide that the rower is not driving him or herself.
- In the case of alternative lodging, the parent/guardian must:
 - Provide the Head Coach a waiver of said desire and release of liability to the team;
 - Provide the Head Coach with a statement that the rower will be accompanied by an adult at all times when the rower is not with the team, including in the hotel room of choice.
